Priority ONE

May survive if life-saving measures are applied

Example:

- Poisoning
- Collapse
- Snake Bite
- Bloat (GDV)
- Heat Stroke
- Open Fracture
- Actively Seizing
- Allergic Reactions
- Traffic Accidents
- Difficulty Breathing
- Excessive Bleeding
- Paralysis



Priority TWO

Likely to survive if care is given within hours

Example:

- Closed Fractures
- Diarrhea
- Acute Vomiting
- Bowel Obstruction
- Urinary Issues
- Birthing Difficulties



Priority THREE

Non life-threatening conditions

Example:

- Skin Conditions
- Lameness
- Sore Eyes/Ears
- Minor Wounds
- Abscesses
- Chronic Diseases
